Level 1 Restricted (low)	Classes will be taught face to face. Measures to prevent the infection should be taken in accordance with the guidelines for face-to-face class issued by the Health Center. Level 2 Restricted (medium②)	Classes will essentially be taught online. Only the courses focused on experiments, practical skills, and practical training and compulsory subjects of each department, and classes that were judged necessary by the university, are allowed to be carried out face to face. Measures to prevent infection should be taken in accordance with guidelines for face-to-face class issued by the Health Center. *For those who will take face-to-face classes, in case your body temperature is 1°C higher than your normal temperature or you have symptoms of a cold, please contact the Health Center. Depending on your symptoms, we may adopt measures to suspend those students from attending to class.

*If students who need medical care or have underlying conditions are unable to attend to face-to-face class based on the view of a doctor, please submit papers including the doctor's diagnosis and observations.

*Even when we carry out face-to-face classes, we will utilize online classes as well for students who have underlying conditions and are therefore unable to make it to class.
